

2023 Calendar Photography Competition Terms and Conditions of Entry

1. This competition is open to both novice and professional photographers. All photos submitted must be taken within the Parliamentary Constituency of Stoke-on-Trent Central.
2. By submitting an image for consideration in the 2023 Charity Calendar, each entrant agrees and acknowledges that Jo Gideon MP and the Conservative Party is permitted to receive their registration data. All personal information will be used and held by Jo Gideon MP in accordance with its Privacy Policy. A full GDPR statement is available on Jo's website at jogideon.org.
3. A prize will be given for the best in each category. The winners of the competition will have their winning image printed in the Stoke Central 2023 charity calendar. 100% of the calendar's profits are to benefit charities in Stoke-on-Trent.
4. Entries must be labelled with the entrant's name, the location, title and date of the photo. For example, 'Rhian Mai, Ponies under the night sky, October 2015'. Photos must have also been taken between 11th July and the closing date of the competition on 30th September 2022.
5. Entries should be submitted by email no later than 12:00pm on Friday 30th September 2022 and subject must read "2023 Calendar Entry". Submissions received after this time and date will not be considered. We regret that we are unable to accept postal entries or entries sent through Facebook or Instagram. Jo Gideon MP cannot accept responsibility for any technical failures or reasons for not receiving a photo before the closing date and time.
6. Images submitted may only be in colour, and manipulation/editing/correction is allowed.
7. You may submit as 3 entries per theme. Late, illegible, incomplete, low resolution, defaced or corrupt entries will not be accepted.
8. When sending your photos, please state the location, title and date of the photo, name and (if attend school/college, please state which one) to:

9. Images submitted need to be in JPEG format and of a high enough resolution for printing in media with a minimum 300dpi. Some mobile phone images may not be able to support these requirements. Panoramic photos may not be suitable for the intended print purpose of these images.
10. A short list of photographs will be selected by Jo Gideon MP. All decisions will be final.
11. The winners will be notified by the 21st October 2022.
12. By entering the contest, you retain the rights to your works while granting Jo Gideon MP and the Conservative Party, the unrestricted, royalty-free, perpetual right to use, reproduce, communicate, modify and display the works (in whole or

in part) for any purpose without any fee or other form of compensation, and without further notification or permission. By participating in this contest, you release and agree to indemnify and hold harmless Jo Gideon MP and its employees, directors, officers, affiliates, agents, judges and advertising and promotional agencies from any and all damages, injuries, claims, causes of actions, or losses of any kind resulting from your participation in this contest or receipt or use of any prize.

13. Images must not;

- Include alcohol, cigarettes, firearms or offensive weapons,
- Include copyrighted materials or trademarks owned by third parties,
- Include any infringing, threatening, false, misleading, abusive, harassing, libellous, defamatory, vulgar, obscene, scandalous, inflammatory, pornographic or profane content,
- Contain any material that could constitute or encourage conduct, which would be considered a criminal offence, give rise to civil liability, or otherwise violate any law.
- Contain or infringe upon any copyrights, trademarks, contract rights, or any other intellectual property rights of any third person or entity. Each entrant agrees to fully indemnify Jo Gideon MP and the Conservative Party in respect of all royalties, fees and any other monies owing to any persons by reason of the entrant breaching any of the foregoing.

14. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that the conditions within these terms are met, any images they submit have been taken with the permission of the subject and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or laws, the photograph they are submitting is their own work and that they own the copyright.

15. Jo Gideon MP reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify and remove any entry what does not comply with any of the requirements listed in these Terms and Conditions. Notice of this decision does not need to be given.

16. All information detailing how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the competitor agrees to abide by these rules. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions. Failure to comply will result in the entry being withdrawn.
